

Copperbelt Energy Corporation Plc (CEC) is a Zambian power generation, transmission, distribution and supply company, operating in the Copperbelt Province of Zambia and the Katanga region of the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC). CEC is a major supplier of power to the mining industry in the region. CEC operates in the DRC market through its subsidiary, CEC-DRC Sarl. he privately-owned power utility is a member of the Southern African Power Pool, a pioneering international power trader in Southern Africa and publicly traded on the Lusaka Securities Exchange with more than 7,000 investors.

The asset-rich business, owning and operating multimillion-dollar power infrastructure, has a network comprising over 1,000 kilometres of 220kV, 66kV and 11kV transmission lines, 48 high voltage substations and a transmission interconnector with the DRC. CEC's current power generating assets comprise 80MW thermal and 94MW grid-connected solar PV plant. Several renewable solar, wind and hydroelectric generation prospects are in development.



Hon. Reuben Mutolo Phiri, MP

On behalf of the Ministry of Agriculture I warmly welcome you all to the 2024 Copperbelt Agricultural, Mining, Industrial and Networking Expo (CAMINEX) which is being held under the theme "Unlocking Opportunities for Growth: Zambia's Landlinked Position".

You are all aware that the El Nino weather phenomenon experienced in the last farming season has had an adverse effect on agricultural production and threatens the national food security with more than one million households affected.

You may also wish to know that 84 out of 116 districts in the country were affected, with one million hectares of the crop planted damaged. The New Dawn Government is committed to putting up measures to counter the effects of the drought situation we have encountered not just in Zambia but many parts of Southern Africa.

The President of the Republic of Zambia, His Excellency President Hakainde Hichilema in the month of February 2024 declared the drought crisis a national disaster and called for concerted efforts in addressing the challenge, which includes realigning the 2024 national budget so that national resources are channelled towards addressing the impact of the drought.

Following that declaration, the Ministry of Agriculture through the Food Reserve Agency (FRA) has commenced the emergency procurement of nongenetically modified maize at elevated prices. This is in pursuant to section 22 (1): (2) (a) and (c) of the Food Reserve Act No. 6 of 2020. This is in an effort to ensure that we replenish the national strategic food reserves to ensure a sustainable national food security.

The New Dawn government also in a bid to address the

adverse impact of the drought has through the Citizens Economic Empowerment Commission (CEEC) put up a call for applications for small sized milling plants, agricultural mechanisation, and irrigation system support and energy loans.

Government has also launched a comprehensive campaign named the "Mechanised 360 Ulimi Okwana" programme aimed at mechanising 500,000 hectares of smallholder farmers' land by 2027 to enhance food and nutrition security across the nation.

This programme will see mechanisation centres of excellence established in each province and in all districts. The established centres of excellence will be responsible to train farmers, extension workers and stakeholders on the appropriate use of mechanisation throughout the country.

In addition, government has expanded the newly introduced Sustainable Agriculture Financing Facility/ Credit Window (SAFF) to support access to financing for agricultural mechanization equipment, livestock and fisheries.

It is envisioned that the country will attain a sustainable national food security with the implementation of the above measures.

I am therefore, glad that, this year's show has attracted a good number of exhibitors especially from the agriculture sector, which has been the tradition of this event for the over 60 years of its existence.

Finally, I wish to commend the show organising committee for putting up a wonderful show this year and I wish you a spectacular show.







Hon. Makozo Chikote, MP

On behalf of the Ministry of Fisheries and Livestock and indeed on my own behalf, I welcome you to this year's Copperbelt Agricultural, Mining, Industrial, Networking and Enterprise Exhibition (CAMINEX). I wish to thank the organisers of this event who have been working round the clock to ensure that this year's exhibition takes place. As you may be aware, this year's theme is "Unlocking Opportunities for Growth; Zambia's Land Linked Position".

Unlocking Opportunities in this sector will therefore, be pivotal to the diversification of the economy as it will not only provide household income through direct revenue for farmers but also enhance national income through exports. In order to achieve this, we can not run away from the challenges that the farmer is facing to achieve the intended goals; these challenges have been in the past year, unique in nature.

The 2023/2024 farming season has been characterised by a drought due to the El Niño which has also affected the fisheries and livestock sector. The direct effects of the drought have been the spread of diseases such as foot and mouth, anthrax due to high temperatures, loss of aquatic terrestrial life, reduced surface water levels and poor pastures for livestock. Indirect effects have been social and economic such as depressed pricing to get rid of stock before further losses, loss in business for input suppliers, loss of employment and reduced protein source at household level.

While all hope is not lost, my Ministry has embarked on a number of programmes to seize opportunities that still exist to thrive and contribute to increased Livestock production and productivity. Currently the cattle population stands at 4,698,972 and is targeted to reach 7 million. The following interventions have been placed by my ministry;

- Improved access to market information systems and establishment of Fisheries and Livestock market centres such as the Mukambo boarder in Mufulira.
- 2) Improved access to finance for production, light-Agro processing and exports.
- 3) Facilitation of domestic and international trade.
- Conducting of Genetic Improvement Program (GIP) for local fish species in order to improve growth and survival.
- 5) Over-sowing of existing rangelands with drought tolerant species.
- Salvaging of wasted maize fields to make silage for supplementary feeding.
- Operationalisation of Artificial Insemination satellites and Multiplication centres to maintain desired livestock traits and genetics for improved herds.
- Disease prevention, control and enhanced surveillance through logistical support to field services.
- Equipping of provincial Laboratories for diagnosis to reduce burden on the National lab.

In conclusion, the Copperbelt Agricultural, Mining, Industrial, Networking and Enterprise Exhibition (CAMINEX) serves as a vital platform for addressing and overcoming the challenges faced by the agricultural sector in Zambia. Despite the recent adversities such as the drought caused by El Niño and its detrimental effects on the fisheries and livestock sectors, the Ministry of Fisheries and Livestock remains steadfast in its commitment to fostering growth and sustainability.





Barrick's Embedded Growth Projects to Drive Value With 30% Rise in Production With the potential embedded in its growth project portfolio, Barrick Gold Corporation plans to double its copper production by the end of the decade and continue to increase it to an estimated 1 billion pounds or 450,000 tonnes of copper per annum by 2031.

President and chief executive Mark Bristow said this substantial growth in copper production combined with the output from Barrick's sector-leading gold portfolio was expected to increase the group's attributable production by some 30% to ~7 million gold-equivalent ounces by 2030.

Reko Diq in Pakistan is positioned to rank as one the world's top 10 copper mines when it reaches full production and the pre-feasibility study on the Lumwana Super Pit Expansion is projected to deliver a potential of 240,000 tonnes of copper production per annum from a 50 million tonne process plant expansion over a 36-year life of mine.

The accelerated Lumwana work program is now targeting to complete a full feasibility study by the end of 2024, which brings forward Barrick's expected production from the Super Pit to 2028. The Reko Diq project also remains on track to deliver an updated feasibility study by the end of 2024. Together, the Reko Diq and Lumwana Super Pit feasibility studies will underpin potential reserve updates and the transition to construction.

Since 2019, Lumwana has contributed almost \$3 billion to the Zambian economy in the form of royalties, taxes, salaries and the procurement of goods and services from local businesses. Local procurement of \$472 million in 2023 made up more

than 81% of total spend for Lumwana. Barrick has also launched a Business Accelerator Program designed to build the business capacity of the Zambian contractors in its supply chain, equipping them to grow and diversify their enterprises and remain sustainable beyond Lumwana's life of mine. "In line with Barrick's partnership philosophy, our REDD+ initiative will uplift our host communities through conservation of the natural forest surrounding the mine. Resources have already been allocated and engagement with the communities is underway. We are in discussion with the Ministry of Green Economy and Environment to facilitate the required licensing and our partnership with local government," Bristow said.

Barrick is a sector-leading gold and copper producer with mines and projects in 18 countries across four continents. Its shares trade on the New York Stock Exchange (symbol GOLD) and the Toronto Stock Exchange (symbol ABX). Its portfolio is focused on high-margin, long-life gold and copper assets.

Barrick is the biggest gold miner in Africa and operates six of the top Tier One gold mines in the world, including Nevada Gold Mines, the largest gold mining complex in the world.

It has one of the longest project pipelines in the gold industry, with growth projects set to deliver an industry-beating production profile. Brownfields projects near existing operations, greenfield exploration discoveries and some of the largest undeveloped gold and copper deposits in the world provide significant optionality and leverage to gold and copper prices.


